## V HD Box

Our V HD box uses 14W when on and 12W when in standby. That comes to 112kWh a year.\*

It also has a clever standby mode, so you can use less energy when you're not watching TV by pressing the Standby button.

If you'd like your set top box to use even less energy, press **Home** on your remote and go to **Settings > Power Saving Settings** and set it to lower power.

## TiVo® box

Our TiVo® box has loads more features and much more processing power than our V HD Box, but still only uses 21W when on and 20W (replace with 11.7W) when in standby. That comes to 172kWh (replace with 118kWh) a year.\*
